1. Make a Plan to Vote

🕒 Vote Early

- Early Voting starts **October 24, 2022**

✉️ Vote by Mail

- Request your ballot by **October 29, 2022** at <https://absenteeballotapplication.alaska.gov/>
- The ballot envelope must be postmarked by **November 8!**
 - ❑ Sign the Envelope
 - ❑ A friend must sign, too.
 - ❑ Provide an identifier

🏠 Vote at your Polling Place.

- **November 8** is Election Day - polls are open from **7am-8pm**
- Polling locations change.

2. Check your Sample Ballot

5. Final Results

A candidate needs to receive 50%+1 to win. If no candidate in the race receives 50%+1 of 1st choices, the race will go to tabulation.

On election night, only 1st choice results will be released. Tabulation will occur 15 days after Election Day, on **November 23, 2022**, once all the ballots from rural Alaskans, college students and uniformed and overseas voters have been counted.
